- Increasing availability (in Germany) of courses taught entirely in English
- Same costs for foreign students as German students, which fosters a perception of fairness

## **Deeper Internet Penetration Enables Greater Transparency**

- About four billion people on three continents are trying to join the organized economy, largely via education
- Inquiries for full tuition scholarships may increase exponentially in the next few years

### U.S. Net Price Calculator http://www2.ed.gov/policy/highered/leg/hea08/index.html

- Mandated by the U.S. Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008; deadline is 29 October 2011
- "Net Price" is the net price for first-time, full-time degree / certificate-seeking students
- Title IV institutions that do not enroll first-time, full-time students are not obligated to comply

## **Comparison Requirements for Different Host Countries**

Tuition Fees, Living Expenses, Visa Costs, Health Insurance, Opportunity to work during study, Exchange Rates

## Financial Course Comparator Pilot, developed by http://www.pieronline.org/

- Accessing comparative data: Useful for counselors and agents
- Assumptions: Visa and insurance costs are negligible; work opportunities are impossible to measure
- Considers three factors: Tuition, Living Costs, Exchange Rates

## What courses are compared?

- Bachelor: Architecture, Arts, Business Management, Commerce / Accounting, Dentistry, Design, Economics, Engineering, Film / TV / Multimedia, Hospitality, Information Technology, Law, Medicine, Nursing, Pharmacy, Science, Vet Science
- Masters: Business Administration, Science, Commerce
- Diploma (2 year): Business
- Foundation Programs (1 year): Pre-University

#### How accurate are these calculations?

- Tuition fees from publicly available sources
- *Living costs* are government estimates
- Exchange rates are correct on the day the report is generated
