Due Diligence Cloud

Our Due Diligence Cloud helps education institutions understand whether applicants or sponsors pose any threats to the institution. During the admission cycle, a quick search in our Due Diligence Cloud assists institutions to decide whether to pursue an application or not. INTCAS has identified how up to 30% of visa refusals are due to issues outside of the application process. Using proprietary algorithms, our system screens students and sponsors against 9 billion public records, searching a wide array of sources which includes sanction lists, politically exposed sources, and social media platforms.

When should a Due Diligence Check be performed?

- 1. Consideration Stage when considering applicants from mid to high-risk jurisdictions.
- 2. Invoicing Stage before collecting funds from a sponsor or student.

Due Diligence Cloud

How does it work?

Once an institution commissions a "due diligence" check, INTCAS asks the student [or their sponsor] to agree to our terms and conditions, and submit various documents. Our engine then sweeps over 9 billion records from across the world. Once all appropriate reviews have been completed, INTCAS issues a confidential Due Diligence Report for that applicant and/or sponsor to the institution.

Using a "traffic signal" system, each case is tagged as



- **Green** signal to proceed.
- Yellow issues have been found. This will be investigated by INTCAS' Fraud Detection Unit. This may include additional reviews from external legal advisors.
- Red issues have raised concerns, and the institution is strongly advised not to proceed with the application.

The final decision lies with the institution.
